PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATION EXEMPTIONS

The BA (Hons) in Accounting and Finance course, depending on the modules students' study over the course of the degree and the results they obtain, carries the following exemptions:

- The maximum **eight** exemptions available from the **Institute of Chartered Accountants in England & Wales (ICAEW), U.K.**
- The maximum **nine** exemptions available from the **Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA), U.K.**
- **Eight** exemptions from the **Chartered Institute of Management Accountants (CIMA), U.K.**
- **Twelve** exemptions from the **Association of International Accountants (AIA), U.K.**
- **Eight** exemptions from the **Institute of Certified Public Accountants (CPA), Ireland.**
- The Philips BA (Hons) degree in Accounting and Finance course has received accreditation from **CPA, Australia**. The Philips graduates are deemed to have met the requirements to commence the **CPA** programme, without the need to complete any foundation programme.
